10. Charging Lion (Supplementary event)	Stalking	4	50 meters	Offhand

International Overall Champion: Aggregate trophy positions are based on the best FOUR (4) out of SEVEN (7) percentage-scores from the CORE events. All competitors competing for the title of "International Overall Champion" MUST compete in a minimum of TWO (2) Stopping Rifle categories to be eligible. The Scorers will collate the International Championship score from the highest five percentages in each category and aggregate them.

International Ladies and Junior Champion: Are to be an aggregate of any TWO (2) CORE events with a minimum of ONE (1) Stopping Rifle category. The winning of a Ladies or Junior medal does not preclude the Lady or Junior from winning any other medal.

International Teams: Each team shall consist of three (3) members and it will be the responsibility of each Country to select their own team members. All team members MUST compete in a minimum of FOUR (4) Core Events with TWO (2) being the Stopping Rifle category to be eligible. The team score is the sum of the three team member's individual aggregate as recorded for the "International Overall Champion"

In the event of a tied score: Fractional scores are awarded at 0.01 for each X ring hits and are used as an initial tie breaker. Any ties after the tally of X ring hits are counted, will be by a countback of 10's, 9's, etc. until the tie is broken.
