Firearm Limits, Exemptions & Special Circumstances



10-Firearm Limit (Pending Proclamation)

- Applies to individuals only
- Does not apply to:
 - Club-owned firearms
 - Dealer stock

If you wish to be considered for more firearms above the current caps, you would need to apply for a [Commissioner's Permits](#)

Available for:

- Discipline shooters
- Individuals requiring more than 10 firearms

Current Status:

- Criteria under development
- NSW expected to be less restrictive than WA
- Junior training pathways under consideration

Primary Producers

- Exempt from mandatory club membership
- Still subject to firearm caps unless exempted

Juniors

- Minors (btw 12-17) are unable to own firearms
- Parents may face restrictions on owning suitable training firearms
- SSAA NSW actively raising this issue with Registry
